- AS9104/9014 - Documentation Team
  - Forward the recommendations regarding AS9110/9120 to the 9104 writing team.
- Auditor Certification – Auditor Review Team
  - Link performance on Witness Audits to auditor competence determination
  - Clarify how a CRB submits auditor candidates to the RMC
- IAQG/AAQG RMC Oversight Process. – Surveillance Team
  - Availability of a risk tool to adjust the frequency of oversight
  - Analysis of OASIS data to support the risk assessment tool
  - Reducing CRB office assessments to once every 3 years
- OASIS – Database Team
  - Enhanced business rules
  - Communicate the availability and use of the database
  - Look at ways to reduce data entry time and reduce errors
