You can also take the opportunity to explore one of America's great Aviation museums. The museum currently owns or has on loan approximately 40 historically significant aircraft. Some have been fully restored while others are pending restoration. Their lineup includes some especially notable airplanes such as:

- Beech Starship
- Boeing B-52 Stratofortress
- 1934 Model 73 Stearman Trainer
- KC 135E refueling tanker
- 1927 Laird Swallow

Explore extensive displays of aircraft and engines from throughout the history of modern aviation. Climb their control tower, built in 1941, for a birds-eye view of the surrounding area. Or, with prior arrangement, investigate their wide-ranging archive of more than 200,000 photographs, documents, books and aviation-related memorabilia.

The Kansas Aviation Museum focuses on aircraft education and memorabilia with a Kansas connection. Our building and exhibits proudly highlight the pivotal role that Wichita and Kansas played and continue to play in aviation history.
