Welcome to Volvo Cars Safety Centre in Göteborg - one of the most advanced crash test facilities in the world, designed to reproduce accidents of many different kinds, from a real world perspective. The crash test laboratory is equipped with two test tracks, one movable (from 0-90 degrees) and one permanent, which enable crash tests of many different kinds, from frontal to side to rear collisions, to be carried out between 2 moving cars at different angles and speeds, and with trucks. A series of other tests, such as rollover accidents or collisions with other objects and preventive safety tests can also be performed in the surrounding environment. The permanent track is long enough to enable the cars to be accelerated to speeds up to 120 km/h. On a yearly basis we perform 300-400 crash tests.
