# Operation Iraqi Freedom

## Fast Facts

- Deployed over 70K US Marines and their equipment
- Offloaded 11 Maritime Prepositioned ships in 16 days
- Lines of Communication extended over 600 miles
- High readiness rates (>98% on MPF equipment)
- Repaired over 4,000 end items during hostilities
  - Put 8 years of usage on tanks in 4 month

# Setting the Force

- Initial constitution actions conducted in theater
- No depot-level repairs in theater
- Follow on actions to be conducted at LOGCOM and BIC during MMC
- Concept enabled quick turnaround of combat capability for Major Theater War Plans
- In theater actions to be complete Oct 03



# Measure of Effectiveness

- Sustained a combat force of 70,000 US Marines/Sailors that traveled over 650 miles in 21 days and defeated elements of 5 Iraqi Divisions
  - While conducting port operations
  - While sustaining rear areas and airbases
  - While conducting maintenance
- Efficiently and effectively “Set the force” for the future
  - MPF capability is ready, further refinements thru the MMCs
