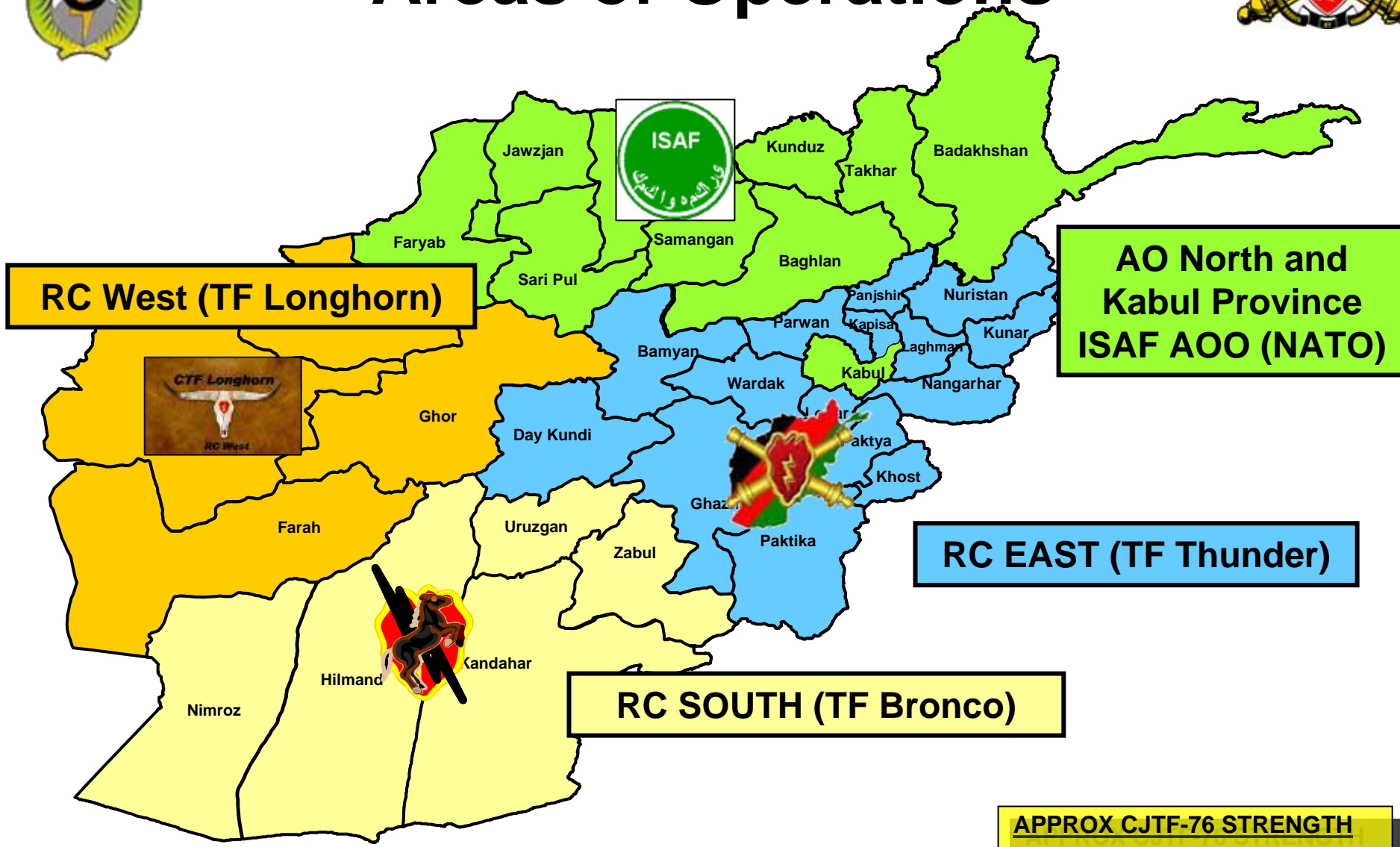


Mission

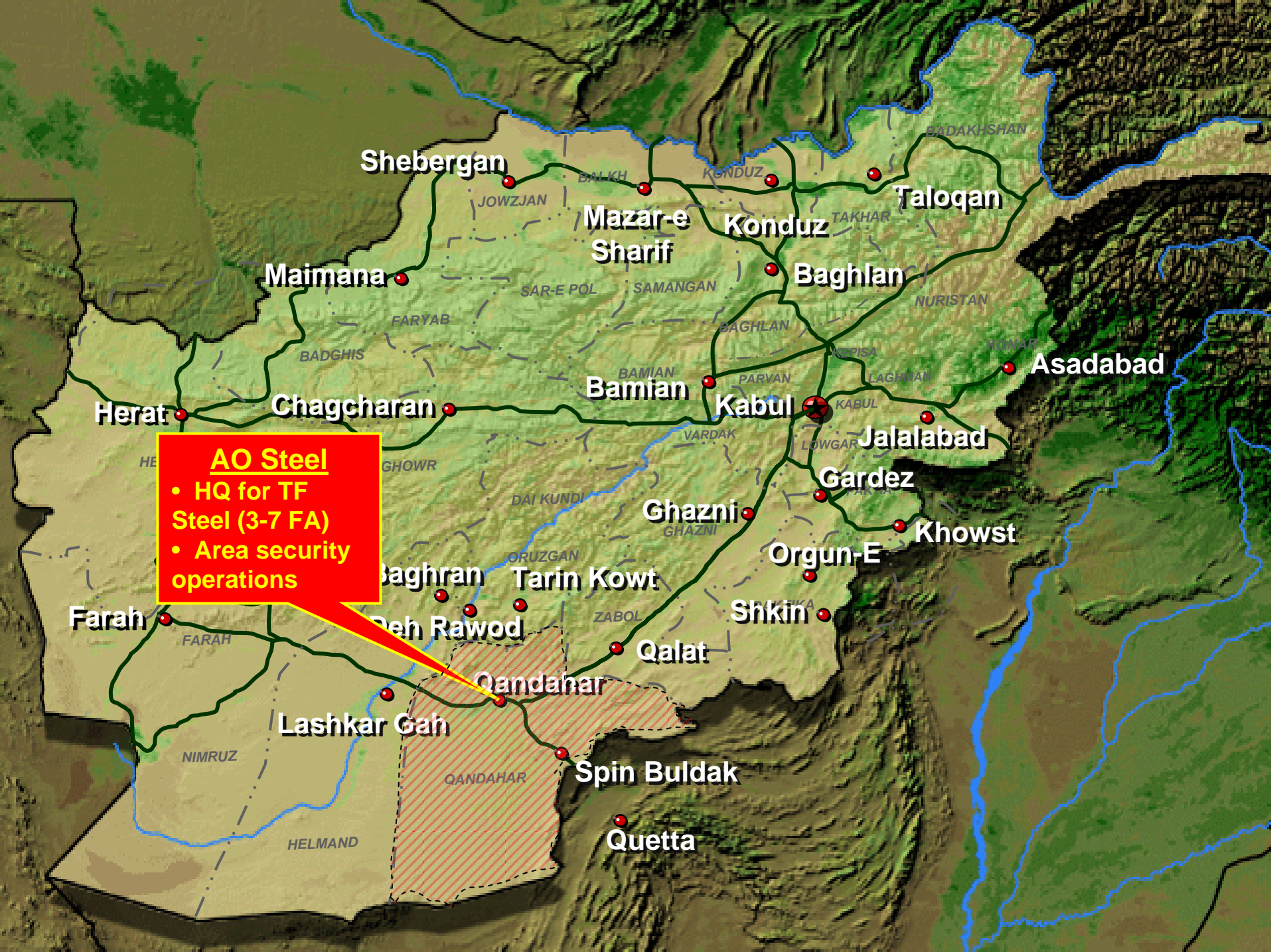

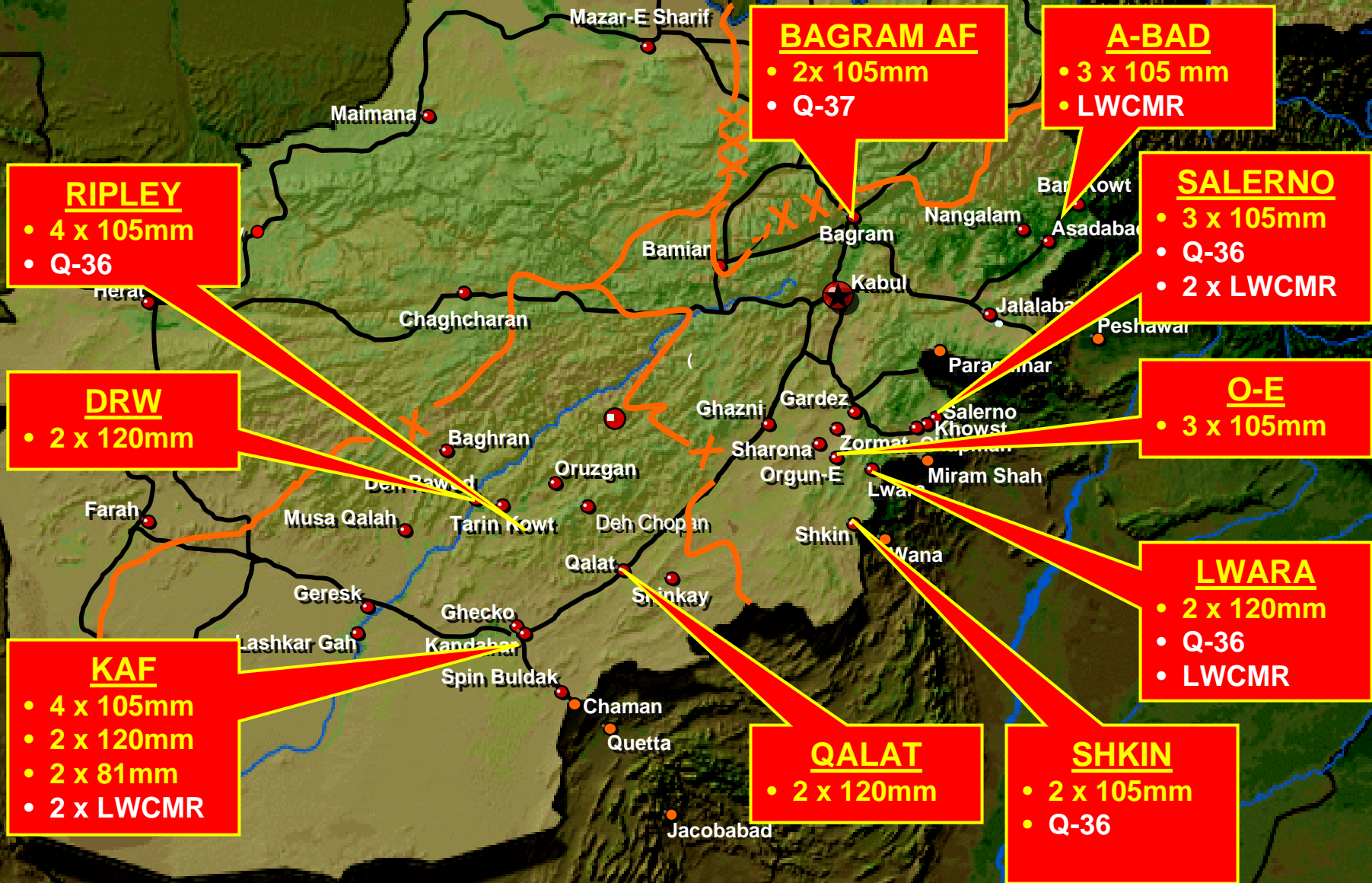

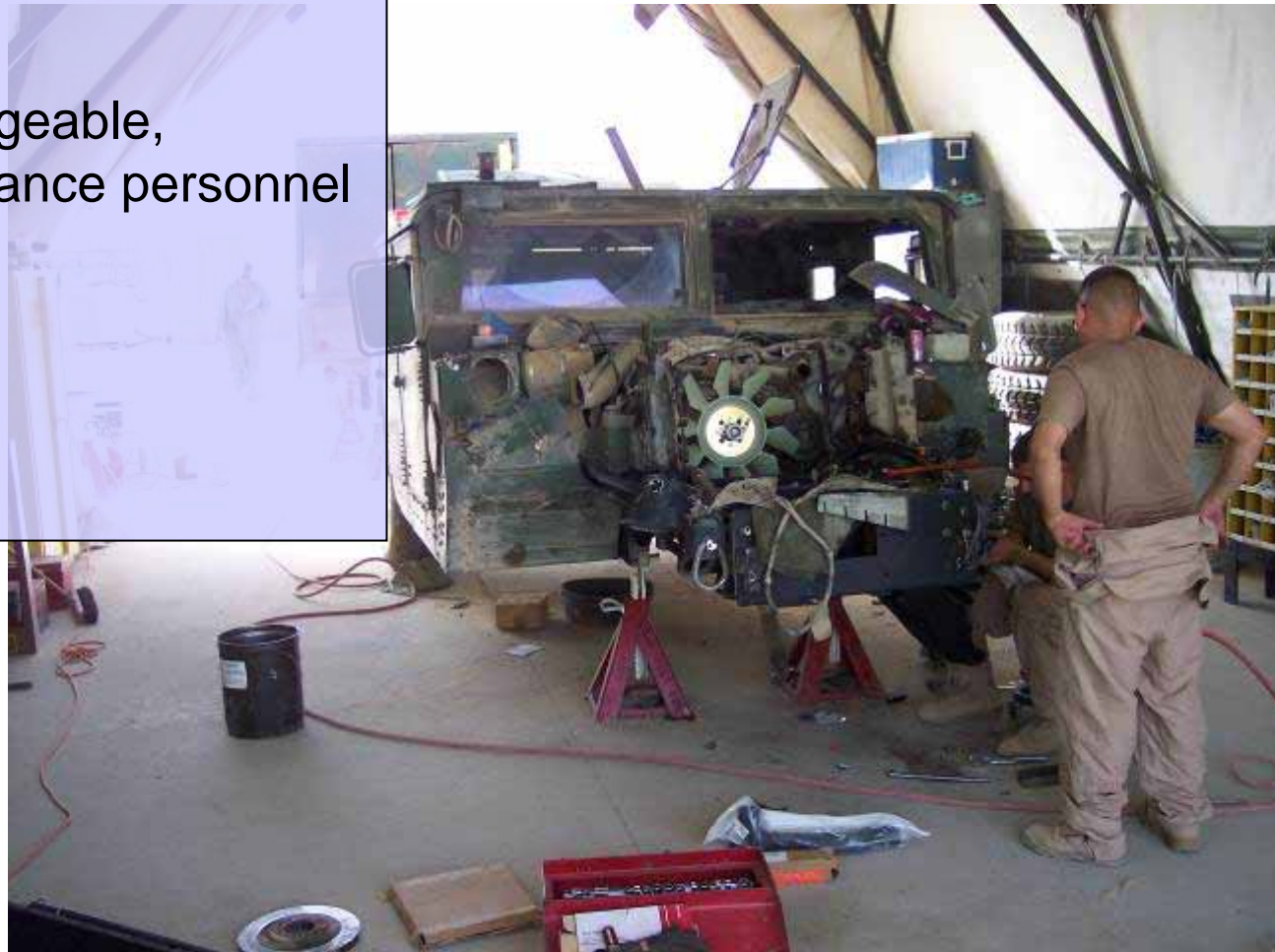
