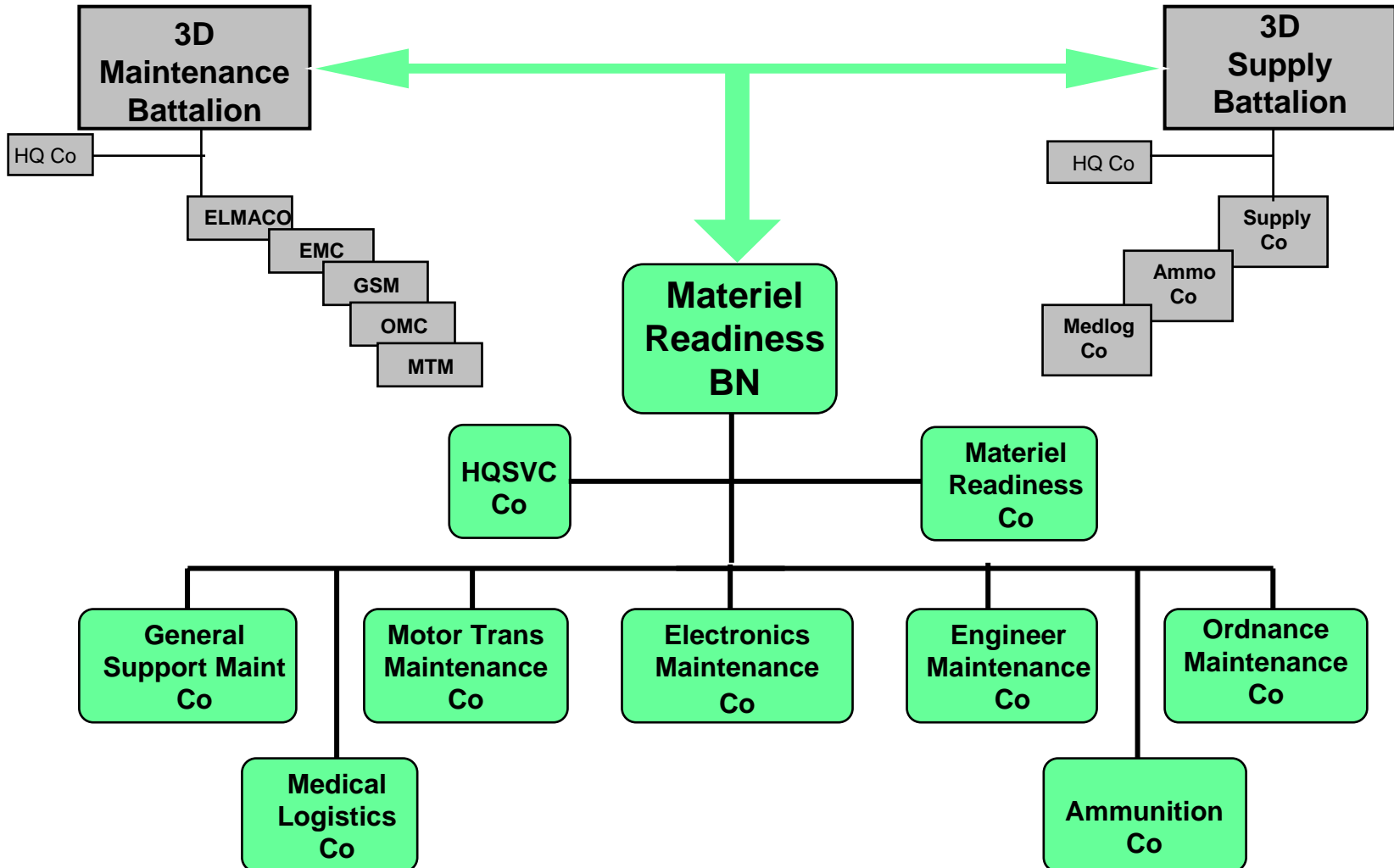

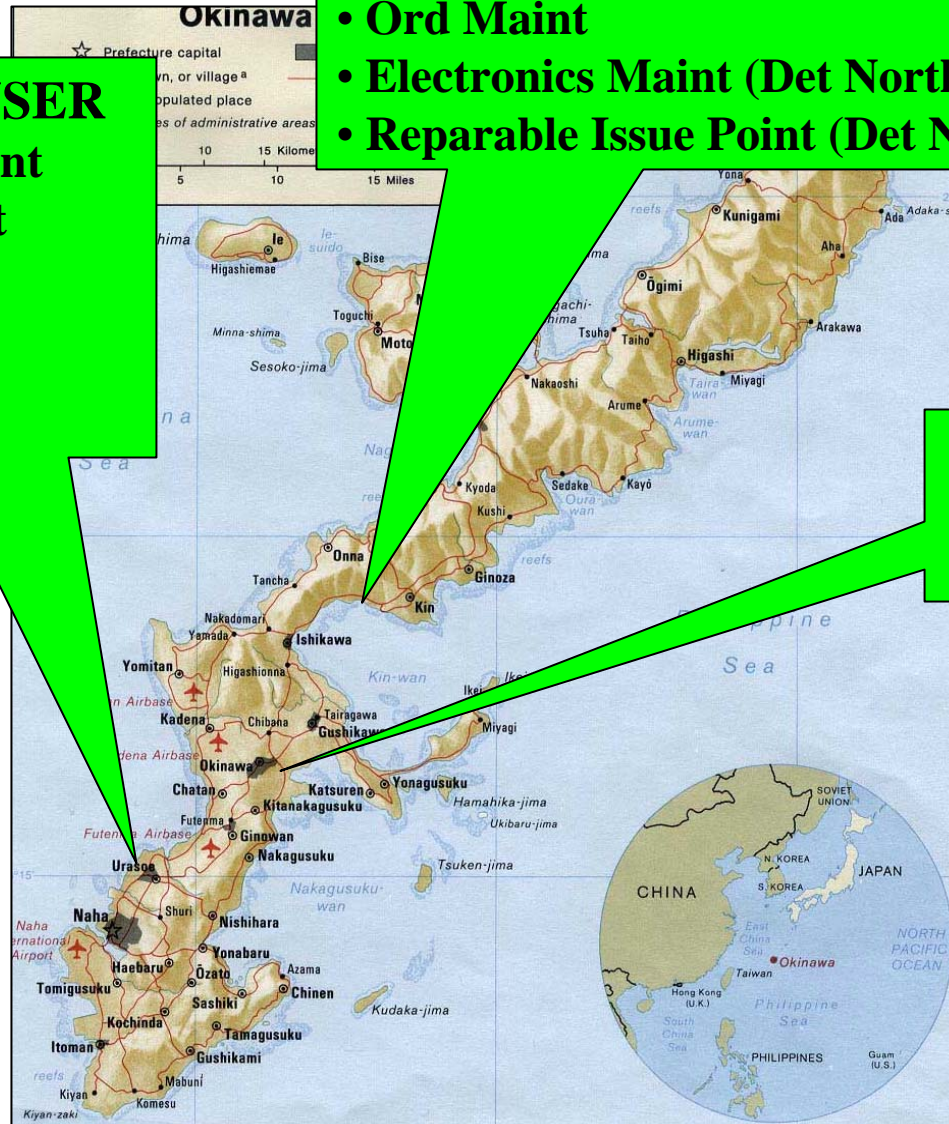

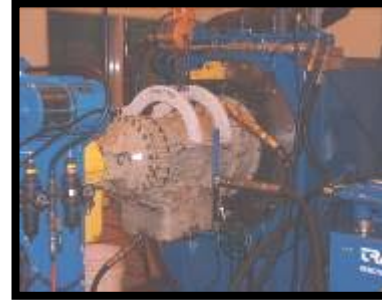

- **\$244,000 in credit from expired medications.**

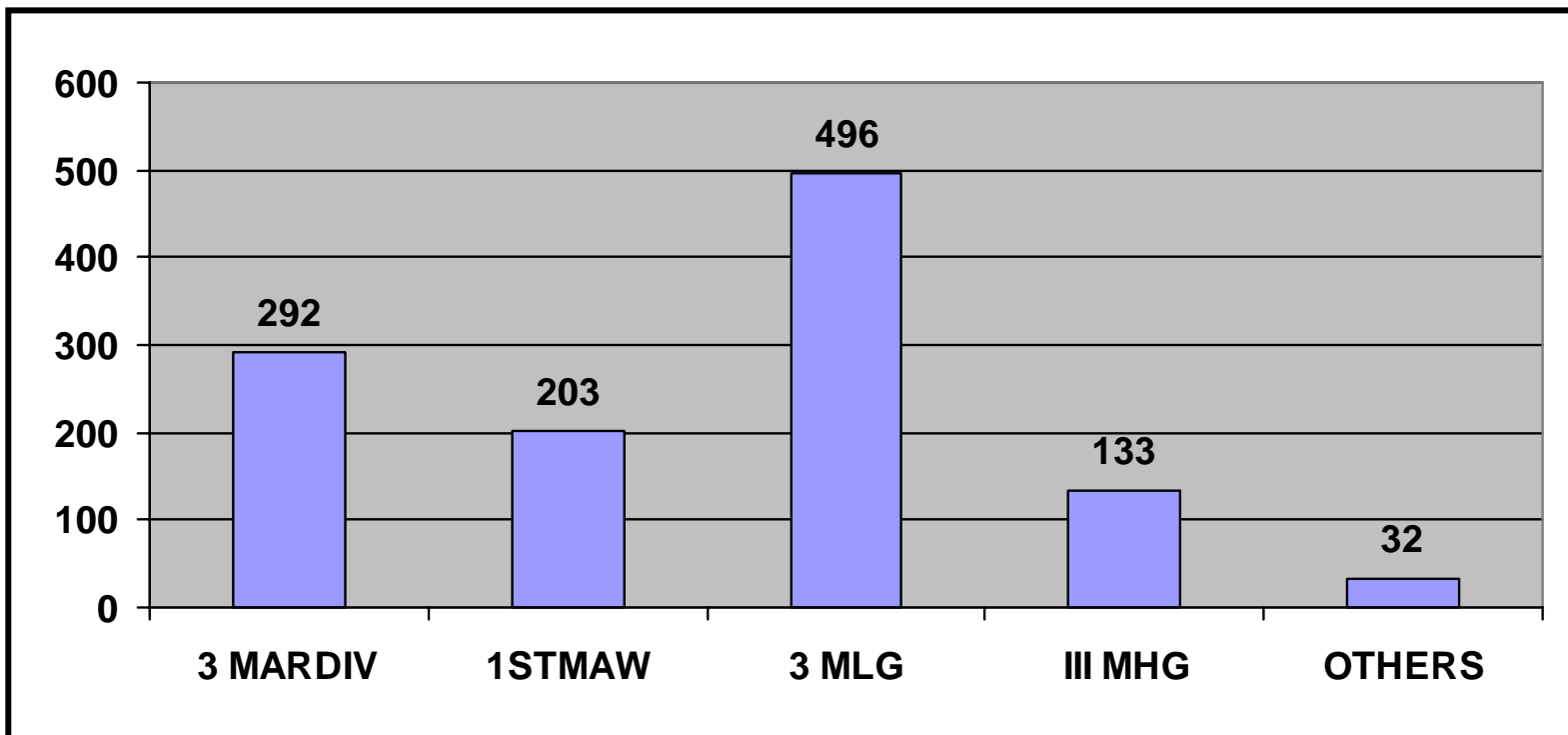

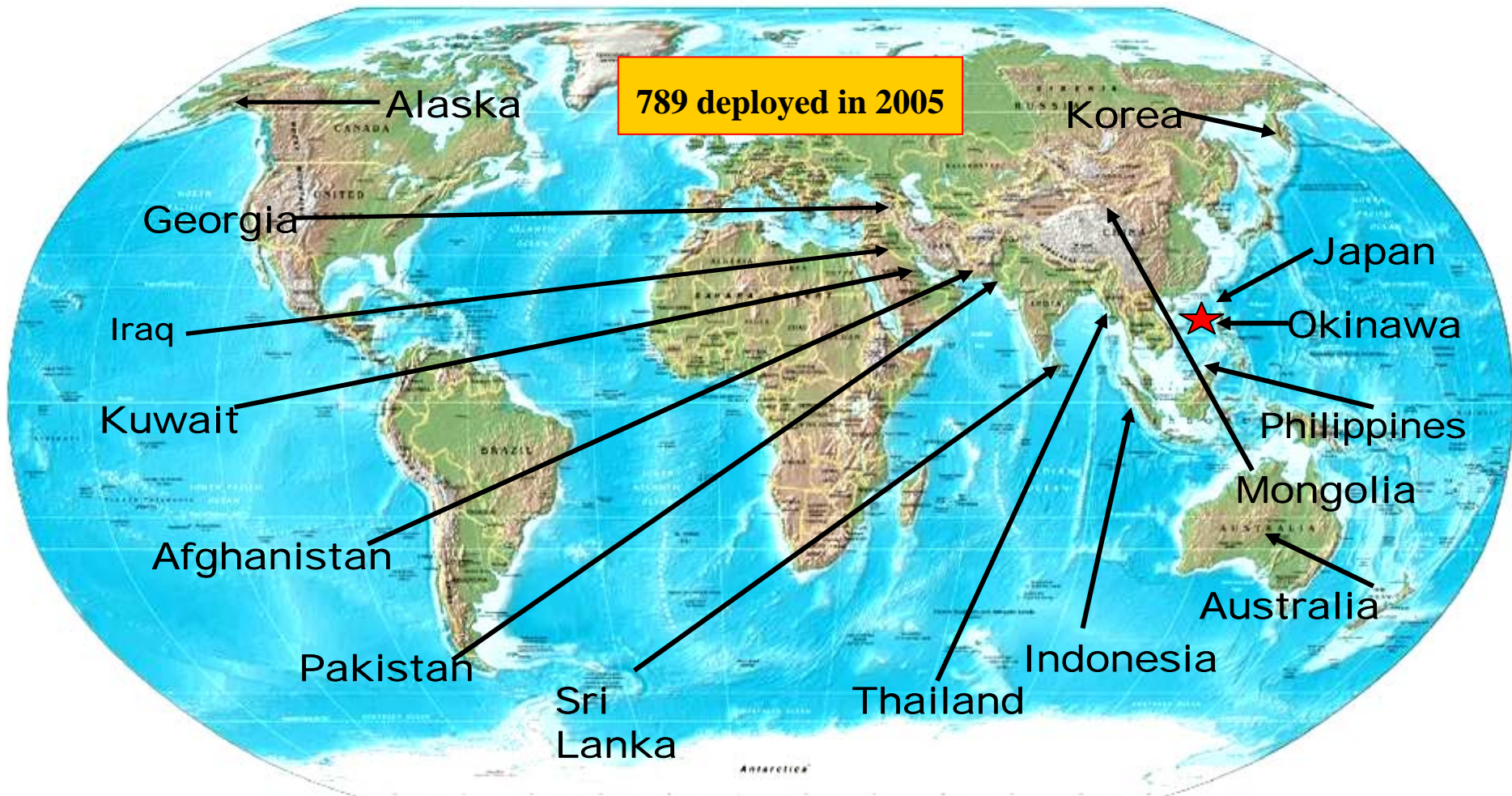

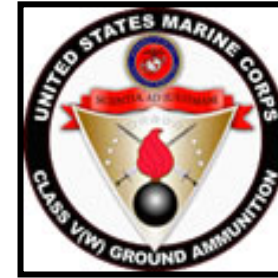


- **Over 90,000 hours community service**
