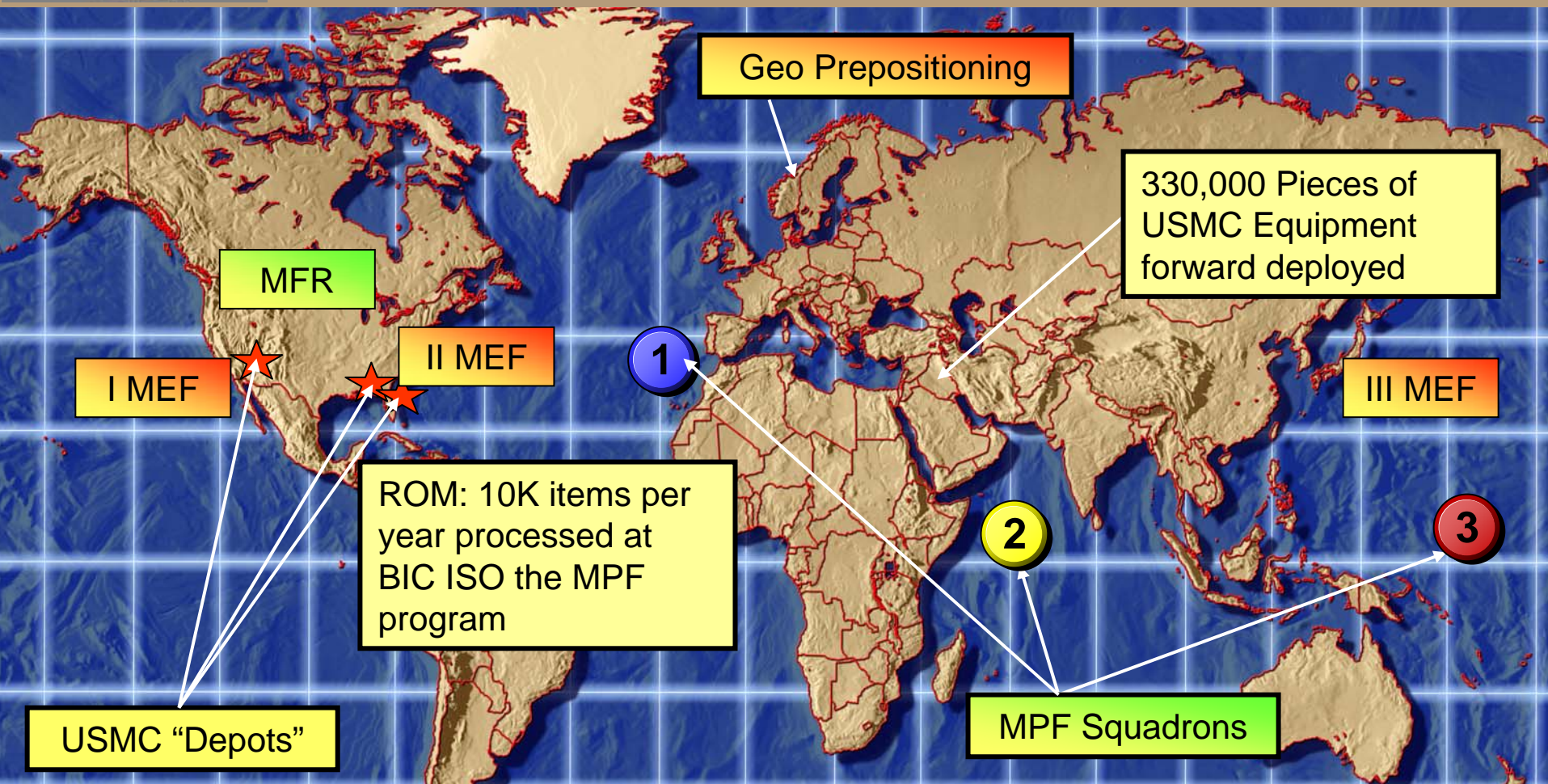

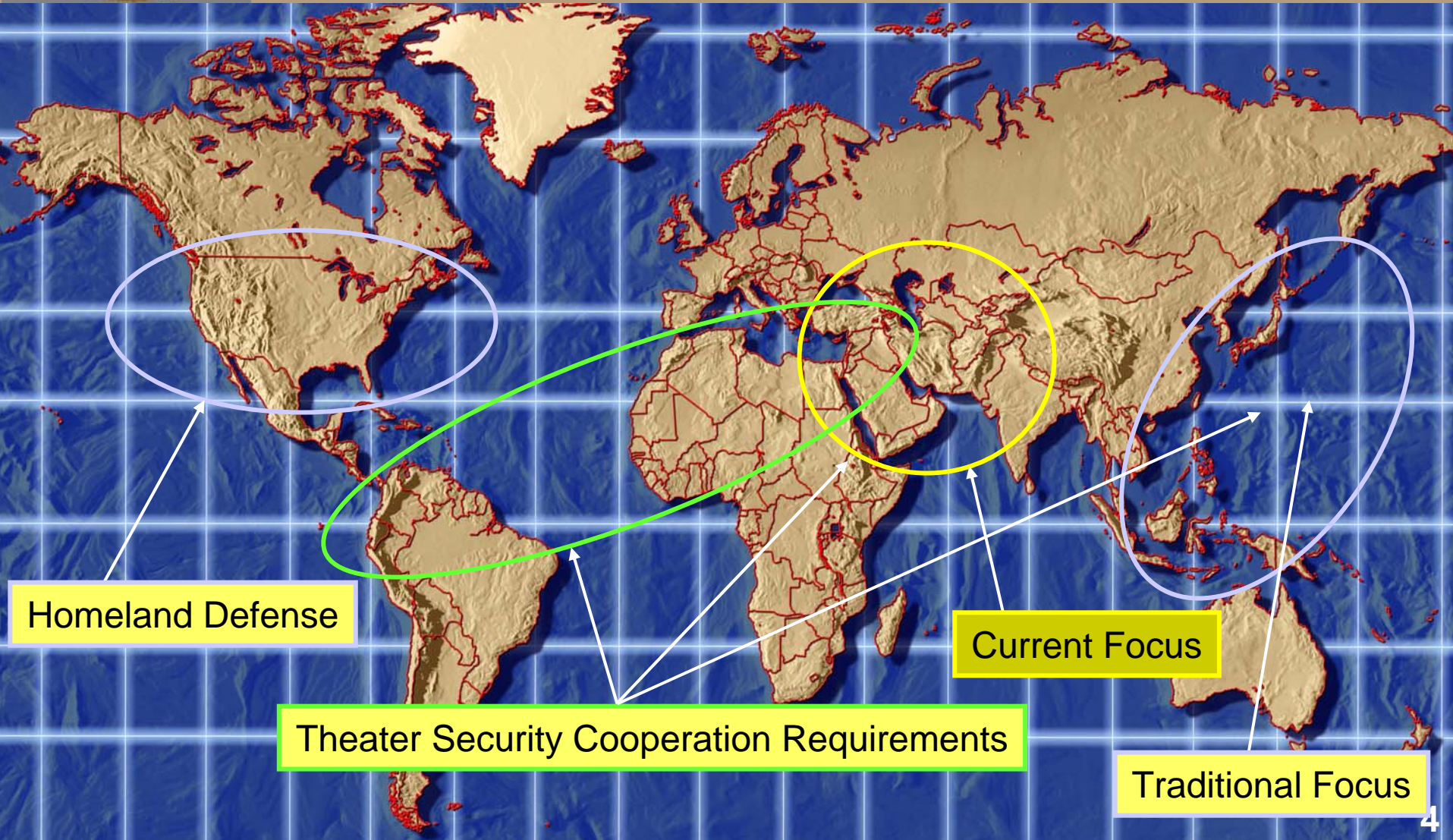
USMC Equipment Lay down

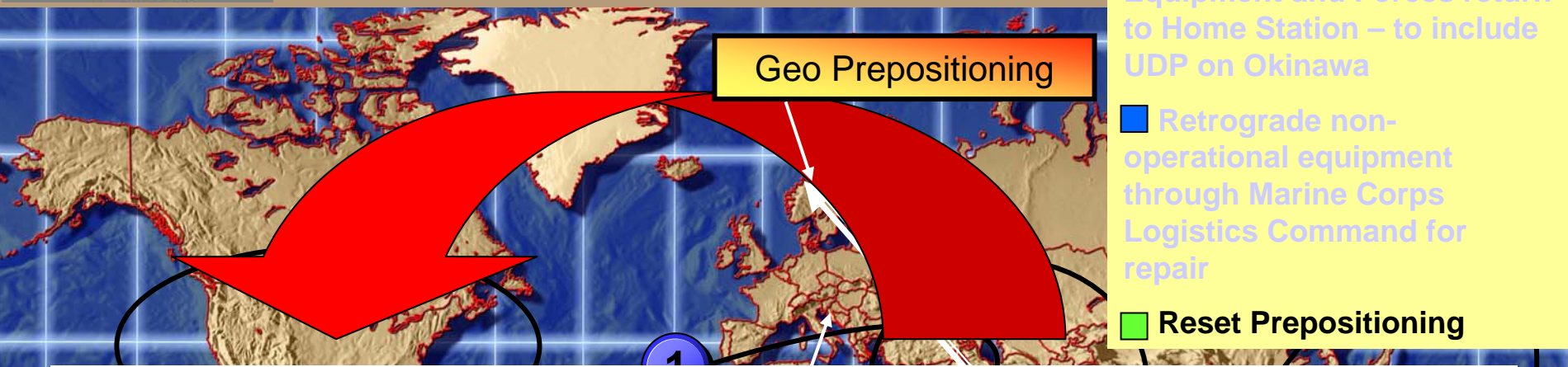
Force Transition





Redeployment and Retrograde

- Redeploy forces in concert with OIF drawdown: Equipment and Forces return to Home Station – to include UDP on Okinawa
- Retrograde non-operational equipment through Marine Corps Logistics Command for repair
- Reset Prepositioning



Ease the throughput issue and regenerate operational availability by putting operationally functional gear in the hands of the Marine faster. Prime the depot's and industry with non-operational equipment and then rotate refurbished and modernized equipment to prepositioning and the MEFs
