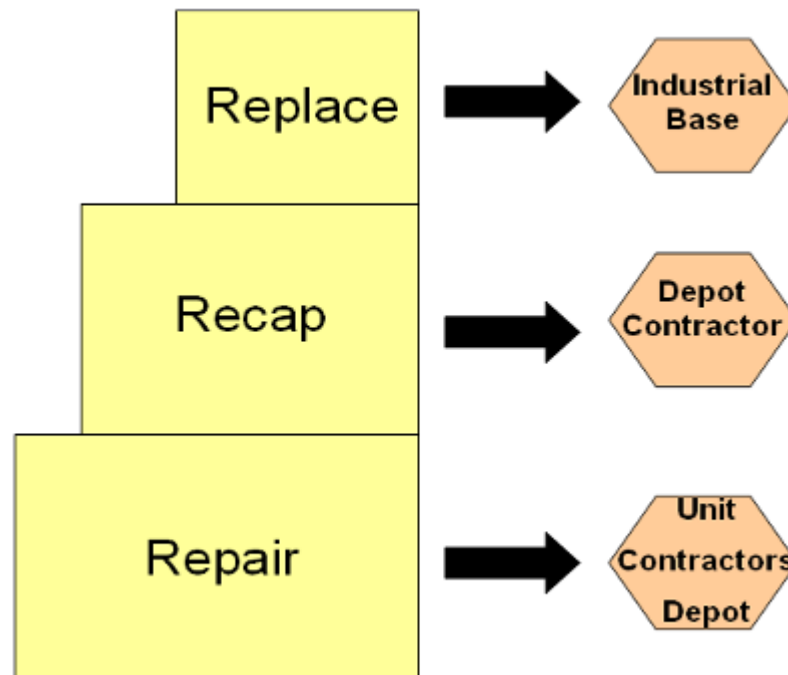

# Army Reset Mission

Purpose: Sustain and reset combat ready units to meet all aspects of Army Missions

Support level of effort to meet the Army requirement to return the force to fully ready status. Reset includes all units involved in preparing for deployment and/or returning from current operations. Reset also includes future deployment missions and capabilities



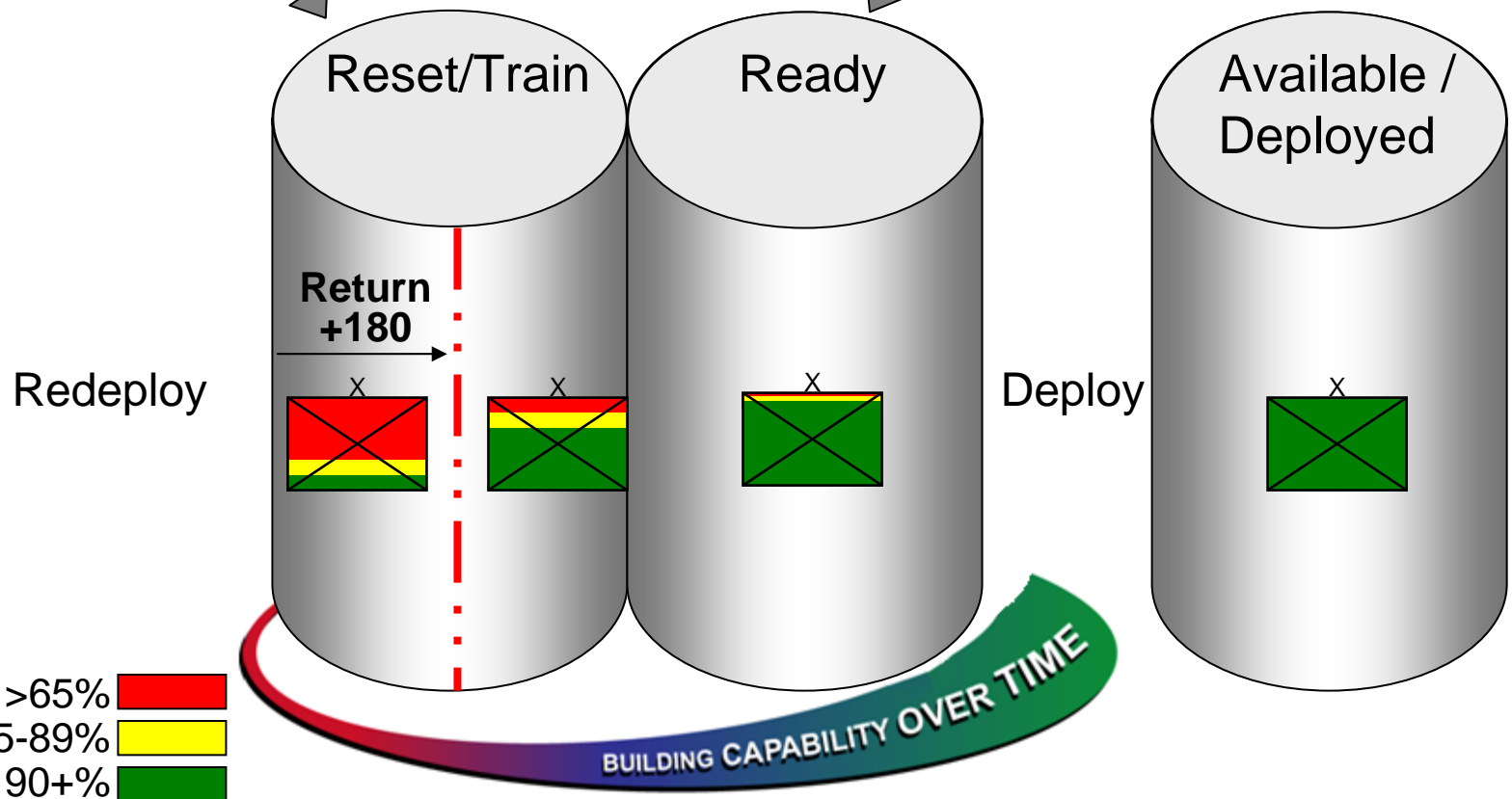
# Unit Equipping Reset in the ARFORGEN Cycle

## Focus - Unit Training & Deployment

- Synchronize deliveries with training
- Delivery rate constrained by
  - Reset production
  - New production
  - ARFORGEN requirements

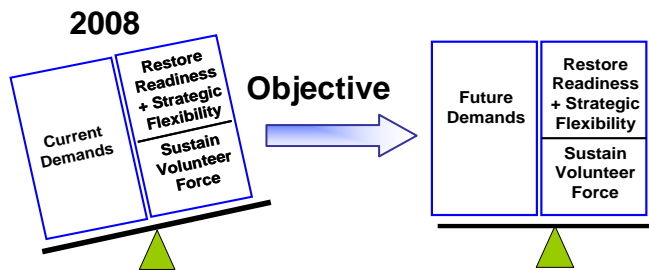
## Identify Reset Requirements

- Before unit deploys
- Project requirements
  - Field & Depot Repairs
  - Upgrades / Modernization
  - Battle-Loss Replacements
  - Reconstitution

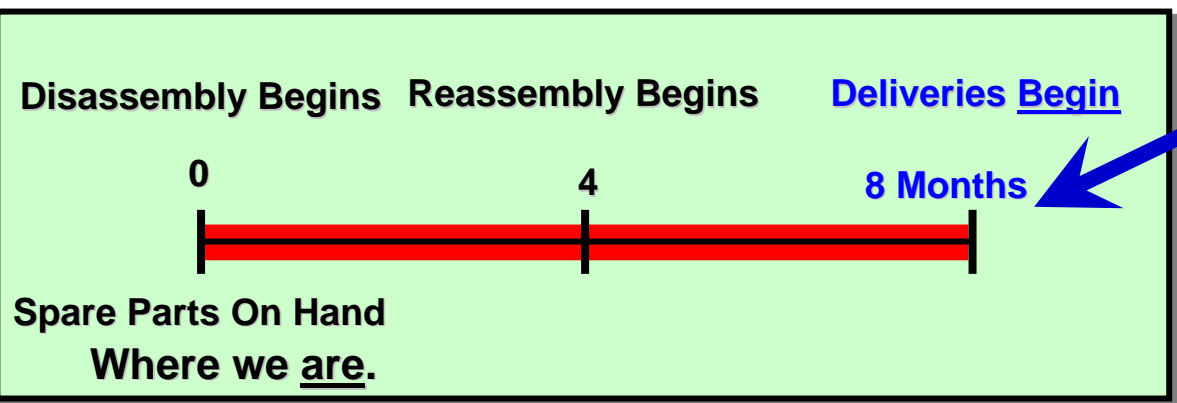

# Abrams Illustrative Timelines

**Abrams Rebuild:** Upon receipt of funding, spare parts can be ordered. Nine months later, sufficient parts are on hand to begin disassembly at Anniston Army Depot. Four months after disassembly begins, reassembly can commence at Lima Tank Plant. Four months after reassembly commences, deliveries can begin. **TOTAL TIME FROM RECEIPT OF FUNDING TO 1st DELIVERY: 16 months.**



**Equipment Deliveries Begin 50% Faster**
