Nomination Deadline: December 31

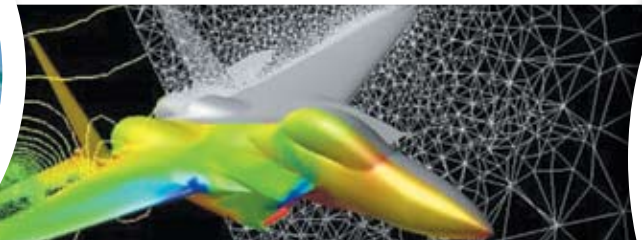
Description

Nomination Deadline: December 31

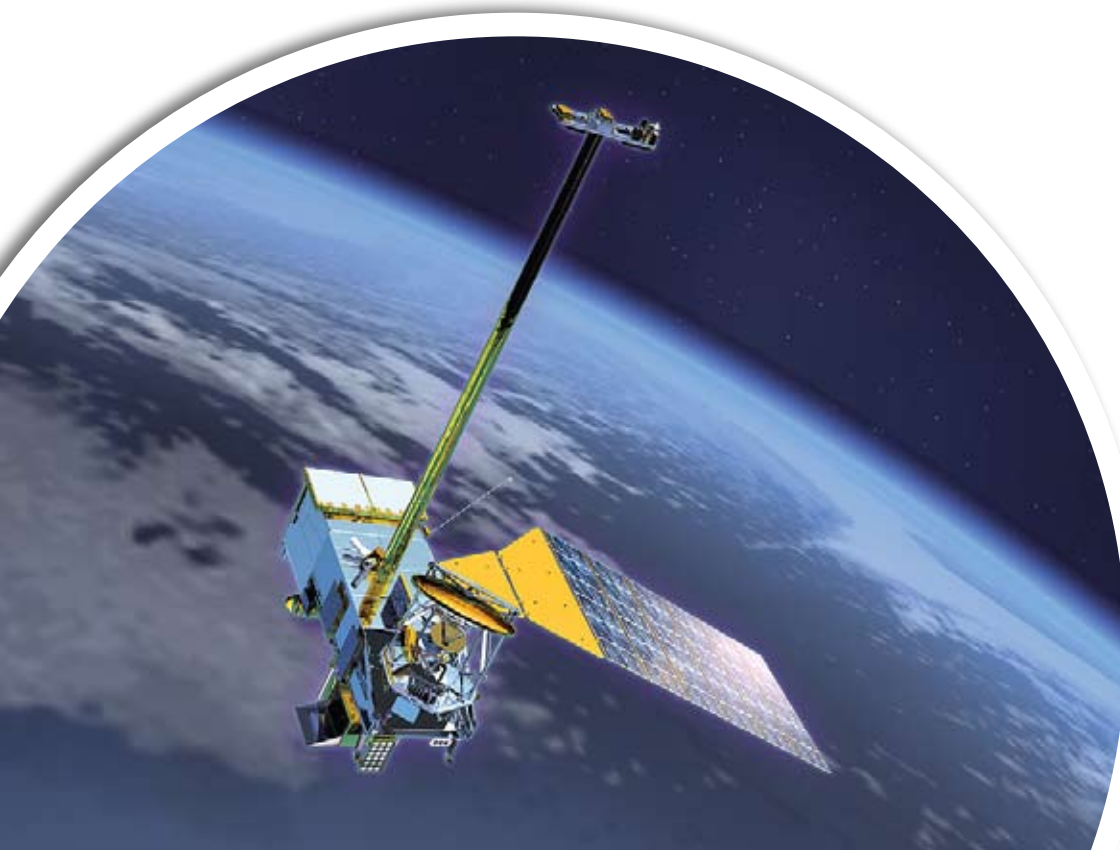
Description
