The Patent Holder states that its position with respect to licensing such patent(s) is as follows: to the extent that an invention the subject of a claim of any of the above listed patents is essential to practising any of the SAE J639, J1658, J2099, J2843, J2844, J2845 or J2912 standards, a licence will be offered, on a claim by claim basis, as required for compliance with such standards, subject to the following provisions:-

1. The licence will be available on fair, reasonable and non-discriminatory terms, which shall include an obligation on the licensee to pay the Patent Holder or its nominee a fair and reasonable licence fee.
2. The licence shall include an appropriate field of use restriction, limiting the licensee's use of such licensed technology to such extent as is strictly necessary to enable the licensee to make, use or sell products or provide services in compliance with the relevant SAE standards and for no other purpose.
3. The licence shall be terminable by the Patent Holder forthwith on notice in relation to any or all of the said claims of the said patents on either (i) the

withdrawal of the Proposed Technical Report or (ii) on the amendment of the relevant SAE standards, so that compliance with them no longer requires use of the inventions the subject of such claims of such patents.

4. The Patent Holder shall not be required to license (and nor shall it be deemed unfair, unreasonable or discriminatory for the Patent Holder not to license) any or all of the claims of any or all of the above listed patents to a third party,
 - (a) with whom there is pending or on-going patent litigation with the Patent Holder; or
