Using a separate sheet(s) of 8 ½ x 11 paper (single-sided), include the following information to support your application. Please type and attach your information in the order in which it is listed below. Items 1 and 2 may be included on the same sheet.

1. Educational Record, Activities and Honors

- List the name and address of the school(s) you attended (grades 9 through 12)
- Include an official copy of your high school transcript with this application. Be sure that your SAT I Reasoning Test and/or ACT scores are included on the transcript along with the number of times taken, or include a photocopy of the official test result reports. Have your guidance counselor include a school profile of the current curriculum and grading system if a standard 4.0 scale is not used. Clearly indicate all courses which are "Honors" or "Advanced Placement" programs. Be sure all transcripts are legible. (NOTE: Updated SAT or ACT scores will NOT be accepted after the application deadline date of December 1. Processing of application begins immediately upon receipt.)
- List all Advanced Placement or Honors courses, when they were taken, and the grade for each course (unless clearly indicated on your high school transcripts)
- List school-related extracurricular activities in which you have participated
- List non-school related activities in which you have participated
- List academic honors, civic honors, or awards you have received

2. Employment Record

- List all jobs you have held. Include the names of the employer, the dates of employment, and the type of work you performed.

3. Essay Question

- One purpose of the SAE scholarships is to encourage and enable students with the ability to pursue a career in the field of mobility engineering (engineering in support of devices and infrastructure for land, sea, and air transportation). Discuss, in 250 words or less, your goals, plans, experiences and interests in mobility engineering. (An applicant interested in fields peripherally involved in the mobility industry, such as electrical or chemical engineering, will need to explain how their chosen field will relate to any aspect of land, sea or air transportation.) If you are applying for the TMC/SAE Donald D. Dawson Technical Scholarship, you must also include evidence of some type of hands-on automotive experience/activity (ex: rebuilding engines, working on cars/trucks, etc.). Essay should be typed, double-spaced, on a single sheet of paper.

4. SAE/Ford Partnership for Advanced Studies Scholarship Applicants ONLY

- Provide two letters of reference; one must come from a Ford PAS instructor
