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Depot Maintenance



- “SECDEF has not developed a comprehensive, results-oriented management plan” to guide future service depot maintenance and has not provided a framework that assures the long-term viability of the depot system”

– *109th Congress, House of Representatives Report 109-452, pg131*



Depot Strategic Planning



- Mandate
 - 109th Congress House Committee on Armed Services
 - Based on the Air Force use of strategic planning to to exceed scheduled aircraft delivery, reduce costs and achieve highest ever on time delivery record with overall improvement in quality within their three ALC in FY 2005, the HCAS requested that the OSD develop an overarching depot maintenance strategy for the department.
 - Strategy to include requirements which OSD broke in to 4 Strategic Elements to be addressed by each service within their Depot Maintenance Strategic Plan
 - GAO will evaluate this report and provide comment and analysis



Depot Maintenance Strategic Planning



- Logistics, and Materiel Readiness Memo dated 9 March 2007, directing Services to conduct “strategic planning for depot maintenance that focuses on achieving the DoD Depot Maintenance Strategy.....”



Strategic Elements



- Sustaining a Highly Capable, Mission-Ready Maintenance Workforce
- Aligning Maintenance Operations Metrics with Warfighter Outcomes
- Ensuring an Adequate Infrastructure to Execute Assigned Maintenance Workload
- Identifying and Sustaining Requisite Core Maintenance Capability
