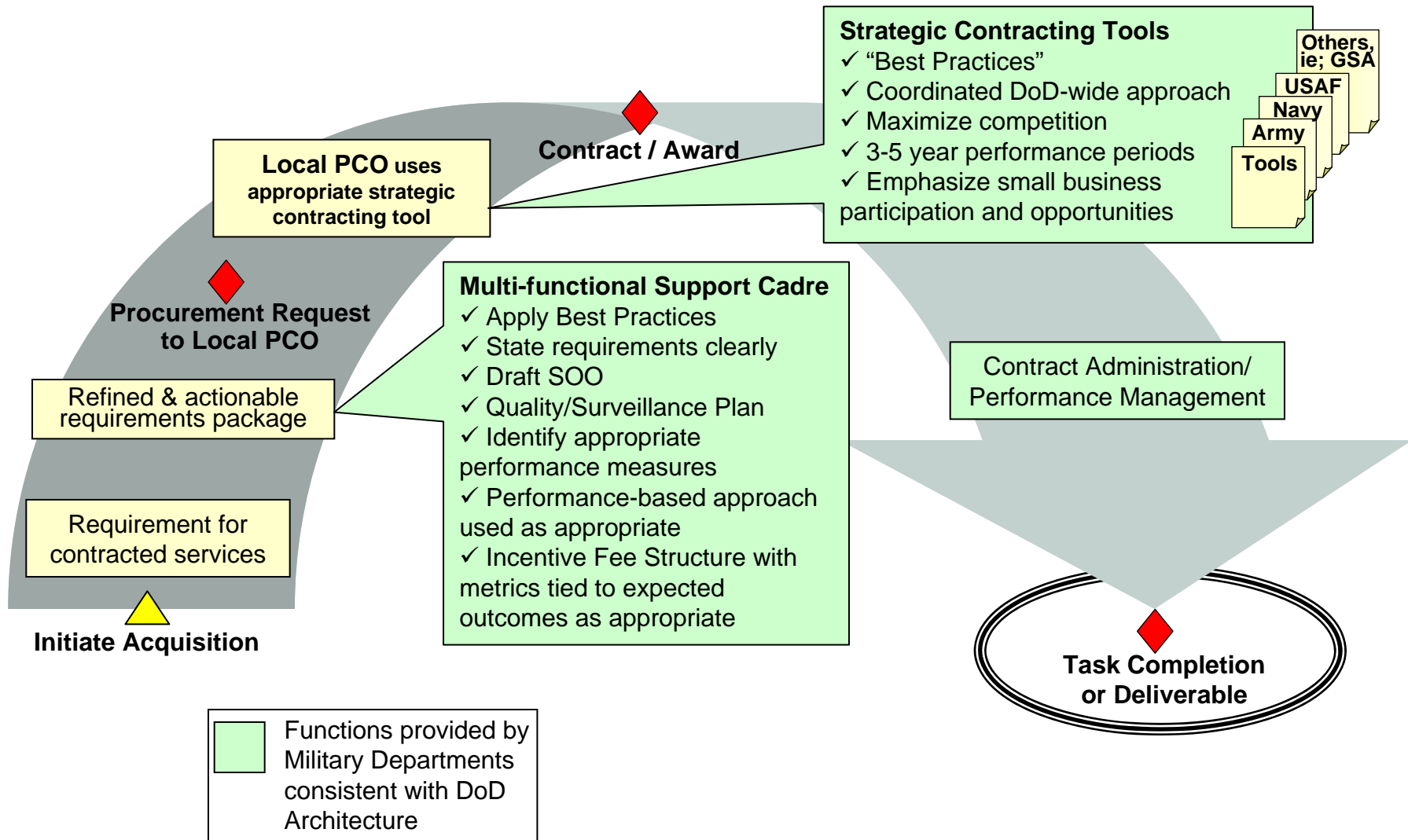

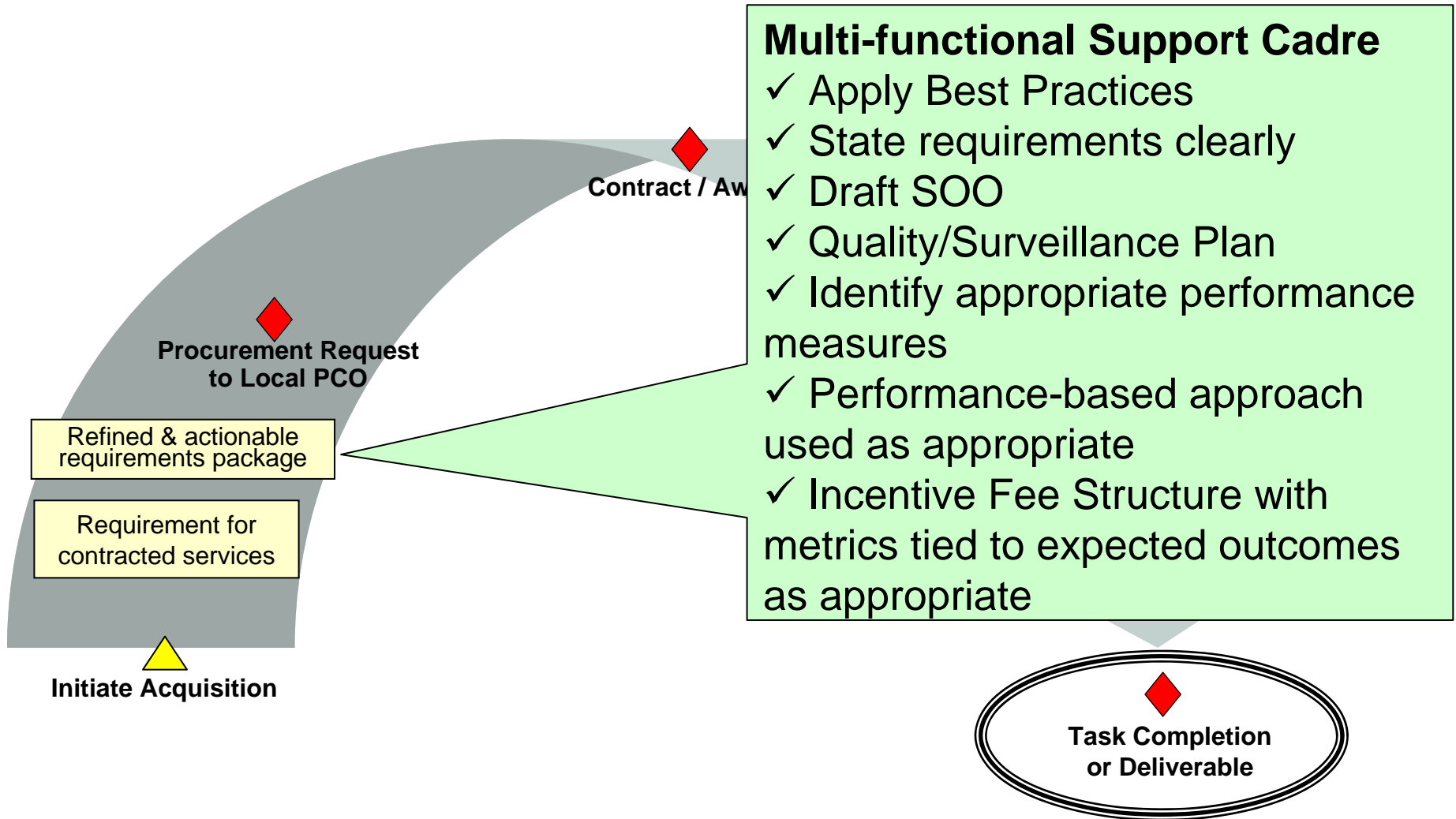

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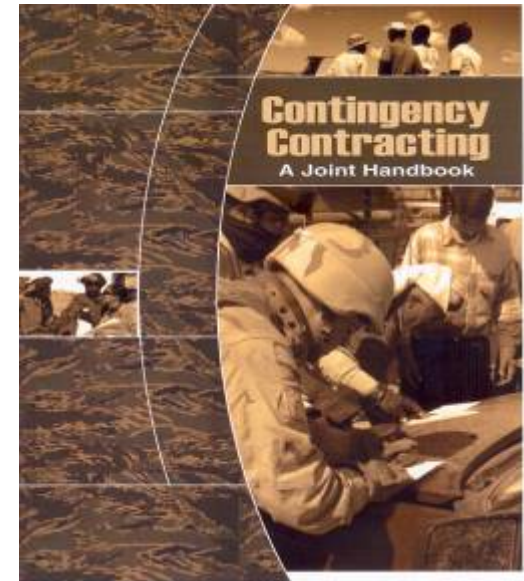

Joint Contingency Contracting Handbook

- Consolidated source of contingency contracting info
 - Provides tools (templates, forms) and training
 - Incorporated handbook into new DAU CON 234
 - Handbook now used for in-garrison/unit training
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- Updating for 2008—revision includes:
 - A top 10 CCO must know list & critical action checklists
 - Emphasis on Domestic and International Disaster contingency ops
 - Updated DVD (more user friendly/mirror DPAP website info)
 - A “decluttered” DVD for reference, e.g., web pages, check lists, PowerPoint presentations, etc.
 - Color code pages to flag critical information

Contracting Competency Model

- DoD developed a comprehensive Contracting Competency Model that:
 - Defines underlying knowledge, skills and abilities that define superior job performance
 - Provides insight into the full spectrum of contracting job requirements
 - Serves as the cornerstone of a human capital strategy to identify and fill capability gaps
- Results will :
 - Provide an inventory of competencies which exist in the DoD-wide contracting workforce
 - Identify current and projected competency gaps and supports workforce development
 - Be used for personal and professional growth by guiding individual development

Theater Business Clearance - TBC

- TBC established October 2007:
 - Purpose is to coordinate/communicate requirements coming into theater to ensure unity of contract execution
 - Ensures compliance with theater specific requirements
 - Requires JCC-I/A to clear contracts requiring performance in the AOR prior to award and
 - JCC I/A may assume contract admin role after award for work in AOR

Thru TBC, JCC-I/A gains visibility & a level of control over the deployment of contracted support into the

JOA
