

7 NEW HOTELS COMING TO BELFAST CITY CENTRE WE **CANNOT WAIT FOR**

With Belfast's serious food & drink renaissance taking off in recent years, it seems like our local hotel industry is also well and truly on the up.


It comes as Belfast is beginning to appeal to more and more tourists as it continues to shed its politically divided image of the past and make a name for itself as a genuine foodie destination.

In fact, such highly esteemed travel guides including The Guardian have been dedicating their time to scouring the city - resulting in the seriously spot on 'Alternative City Guide To Belfast (https://www.theguardian.com/travel/2016/jul/26/alternativecity-guide-belfast-northern-ireland)' which included some of our favourite under the radar spots (http://www.belfastvibe.com/bigstories/the-guardians-alternative-cityguide-to-belfast-is-seriously-spot-on/).

There's now almost two dozen new hotels in the works in Belfast - here's the ones we're keeping our eyes on!

1. BULLITT

Bullitt is the new £4million state-of-theart hotel coming to Belfast's city centre.

Wrapping Victoria Street and Ann Street, Bullitt is the latest brainchild of the Beannchor Group - the dynamic team responsible for some of Belfast's most attractive hotspots, from the city's five-star Merchant Hotel, The National Grande Café and Sixty6, The Dirty Onion, Little Wing Pizzeria and over 40 pubs across Northern Ireland!

Named after the Steve McQueen movie of the same name, Bullitt Belfast is a vibrant new space that will provide a cool new space for people to 'work, play and stay in the heart of the city.'

It will boast 43 stylish bedrooms, three bars (including Baltic, NI's first skithemed bar), a courtyard garden, a 68seater restaurant 'Taylor and Clay', an Espresso bar and a versatile private events space.

Perhaps most amazingly - it is set to open in mid-October! 2. CITY QUAYS HOTEL

It has just been announced that Marriott International has been selected as the brand for the new City Quays Hotel on Belfast's waterfront under a franchise operating agreement with Interstate Europe Hotels and Resorts.

City Quays Hotel will be Belfast's newest waterfront hotel. An upper mid-scale hotel, the 4 Star development will feature a reception area, restaurant, bar/ lounge, gym, meeting rooms and a staggering 188 bedrooms!

The swanky new hotel is aiming for a grand opening in early 2018 - and we're very excited about seeing the end result!

3. BOUTIQUE TRAVEL HOTEL

Bank Square



Plans to build a boutique hotel in the city centre's Bank Square have just been given the green light.

Belfast City Council's Planning Committee tonight granted planning permission on Tuesday for a four storey 'boutique travel hotel' with 17 bedrooms and a ground floor restaurant on Bank Square beside the Mourne Seafood Bar and Kelly's Cellars.

Permission was also granted for a four storey extension to the Holiday Inn Express on University Street to provide 60 new bedrooms.

"We are pleased to see Belfast's tourism infrastructure being further boosted by these two developments as our city's popularity as a visitor destination continues to grow" said Councillor Peter Johnston, Chair of the Planning Committee.

4. BELFAST GRAND CENTRAL HOTEL

Windsor House



Work is also underway on the £30m Belfast Grand Central hotel.

The four-star, 200-bedroom building will transform 23-storey Windsor House, which owners Hastings Hotels bought for £6.5m.

Last year, Hastings Hotels unveiled plans to transform Windsor House in Belfast - one of Ireland's tallest buildings - making it the seventh addition to the hotel chain.

The Belfast Grand Central Hotel will also include 16 serviced apartments and new ground floor retail units, as well as refurbished office space on the upper floors of the 24-storey building.

It's set to create an impressive 150 jobs when it opens in 2018.

5. THE BEDFORD HOTEL







The £12m boutique project suffered a fair few setbacks when it was hit with delays caused by a government funding shortfall last year.


But so far we know that the six-storey building on Donegall Square South appointed Dublin-based architects Douglas Wallace to oversee the design of the project in early 2015.

Work was expected to kick off shortly after, with the owners optimistic that the project - which has now been extended to include 67 bedrooms - would be ready soon.

Belfast City Hall

One of Belfast's most iconic buildings, Belfast City Hall first opened its doors in August 1906 and is Belfast's civic building. It's located in Donegall Square, in the heart of Belfast city centre. Take a free public tour and discover its fascinating history.

Free public tours of Belfast City Hall are available Monday to Sunday. Led by an experienced guide, they last around one hour and uncover the history of Belfast City Hall, while exploring some of its finest features. You can also visit the Titanic Memorial Garden and a number of monuments and memorials.

Look out for the Belfast City Hall illuminations as they light up the building in a variety of colours and combinations at night, showing off the building's beautiful architectural features.

Free Tours

Free public tours are available:

- · Monday to Friday: 11am, 2pm and 3pm
- · Saturday and Sunday: 12noon, 2pm and 3pm

The front doors of Belfast City Hall are open on Saturday and Sunday from 10am - 4pm.

Tours on bank holidays and public holidays are subject to change. For further information, please visit www.belfastcity.gov.uk/tours. ((http://www.belfastcity.gov.uk/tours)

Tours are available on a first-come, first-served basis (no booking required) and leave from the reception area inside Belfast City Hall.

You can book private group tours in advance and outside of public tour times.

Titanic Memorial Garden

The Titanic Memorial Garden is situated on the east side of Belfast City Hall. The garden was built around the existing Titanic monument which was designed by Sir Thomas Brock. The garden is set on two levels with the upper level containing a nine metre long plinth supporting 15 bronze plaques which list, in alphabetical order, the names of 1,512 people who perished on RMS Titanic. This is the first time that the names of everyone who perished have been recorded on one monument. The Belfast List', as it is now known, is a key feature of the memorial garden.

Visitor Exhibition

The City Hall's east wing on the ground floor hosts a tourist exhibition, which can be accessed through its own dedicated reception area. The exhibition offers a journey

from the city's past to present, showing the vibrancy and diversity of Belfast City Hall across six themed zones.

Stretching over 16 separate rooms, and presented within the original architecture of City Hall, you can explore the various rooms, and pause for thought in the reflection space or take time out for lunch or refreshments in our refurbished coffee shop, The Bobbin.

The exhibition is free for individuals (there's a charge for commercial groups) but for £3.50 you can hire headphones and listen to an audio tour, available in a range of languages. You can also buy a commemorative booklet for just £1.
